ELSENHAM QUARRY Planning Application

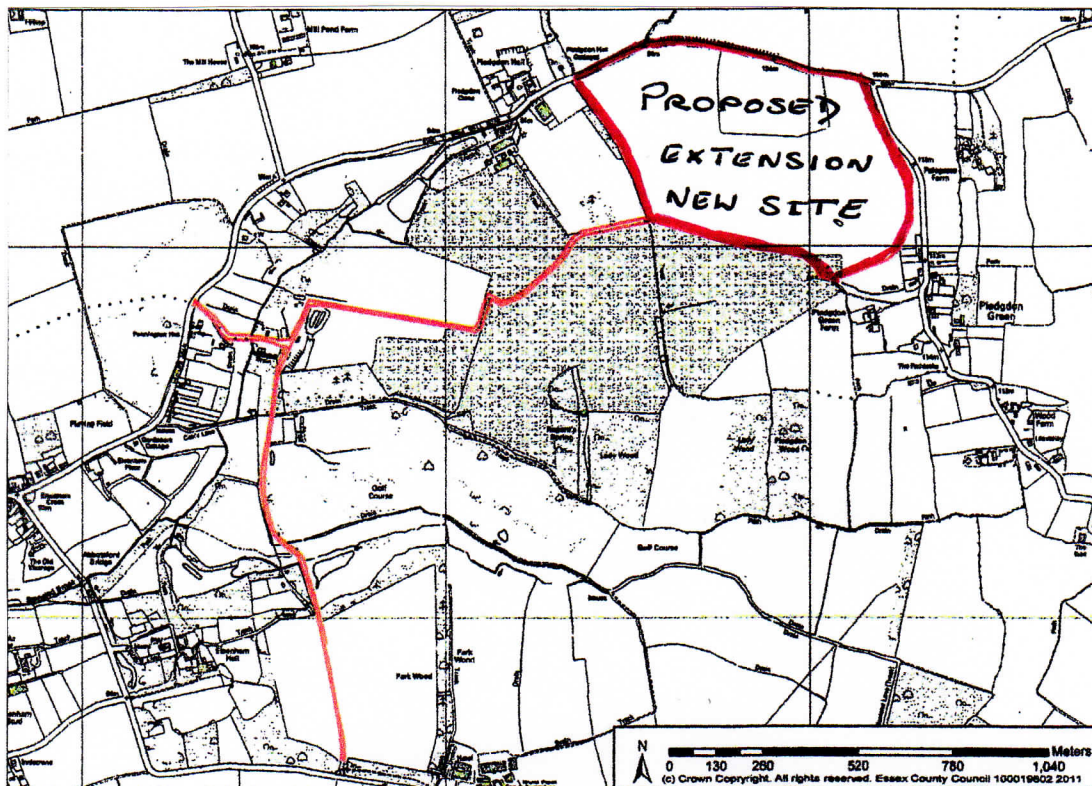
Brett Aggregates Limited have submitted an application to Essex County Council (ECC) for the following:

'Extraction of sand as an extension to the existing quarry with restoration to agriculture at lower level (without landfill), including retention of existing access, office & weighbridge'. (Application No: ESS/50/11/UTT).
